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What is a FAR System?

- Database containing information on faculty and their professional activities
 - **Profile** (supplied by faculty member)
 - **Teaching** (automated import from Banner)
 - **Research/Scholarship/Creative Activity** (automated import from commercial databases such as Web of Science and Scopus)
 - **Engagement** (supplied by faculty member)
 - **Institutional and Professional Service** (supplied by faculty member)

Why a FAR System?

- Make reporting by faculty, departments, colleges less burdensome to all
- Showcase efforts of our faculty
- Lessen the frequency of requests for information from faculty
- Facilitate collaboration

Why Elements?

- Designed by academics for use by academics
- Relatively new company dedicated to customer service
- Opportunities for customizing product
- Best product for the money through an RFP process

Future Uses for Elements

- Producing reports for annual performance evaluation
- Producing reports for Promotion and Tenure dossiers
- Producing reports for departmental / collegiate achievements
- Compliance, Accreditation, and other data demands
