

Report of the Appeals Committee 2014-2015

The Appeals Committee met eight times during the academic year. The following activities were conducted at these meetings:

- The committee read and discussed at length each newly received appeal.
- For each newly received appeal, the committee decided whether or not a review panel should be appointed. If appropriate, the committee chair appointed a panel and designated one member as chair of the panel.
- The committee reviewed each report prepared by a review panel, and decided whether or not to accept the report.
- The committee or its chair met on an as-needed basis with the chief academic officer.
- The committee conducted three special reviews as per section 3.12.1.4 of the *Faculty Handbook*.

The Appeals Committee began the academic year with one active case. During the 2014–2015 academic year the Faculty Appeals Committee received four new appeals and closed four cases. As of April 27, 2015 there is one active case. This information is summarized in the following table:
