- 88% of UG are in-state
- 14% of graduates/professionals are international
- 17 countries and 44 states (Fall 2015)

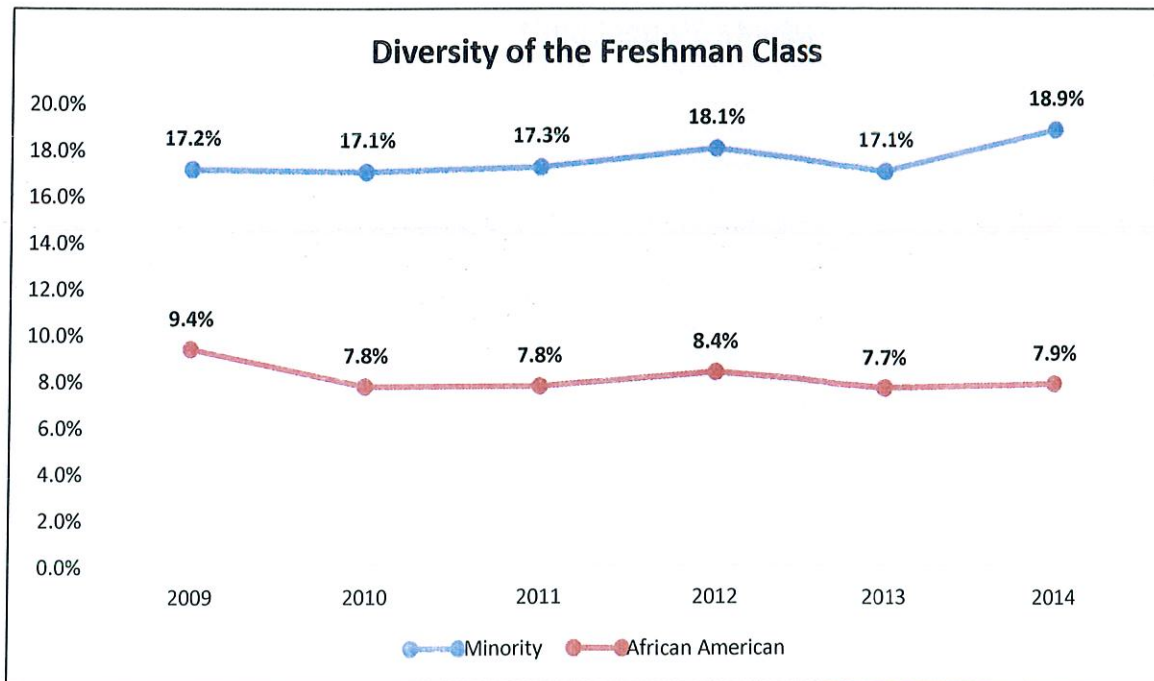

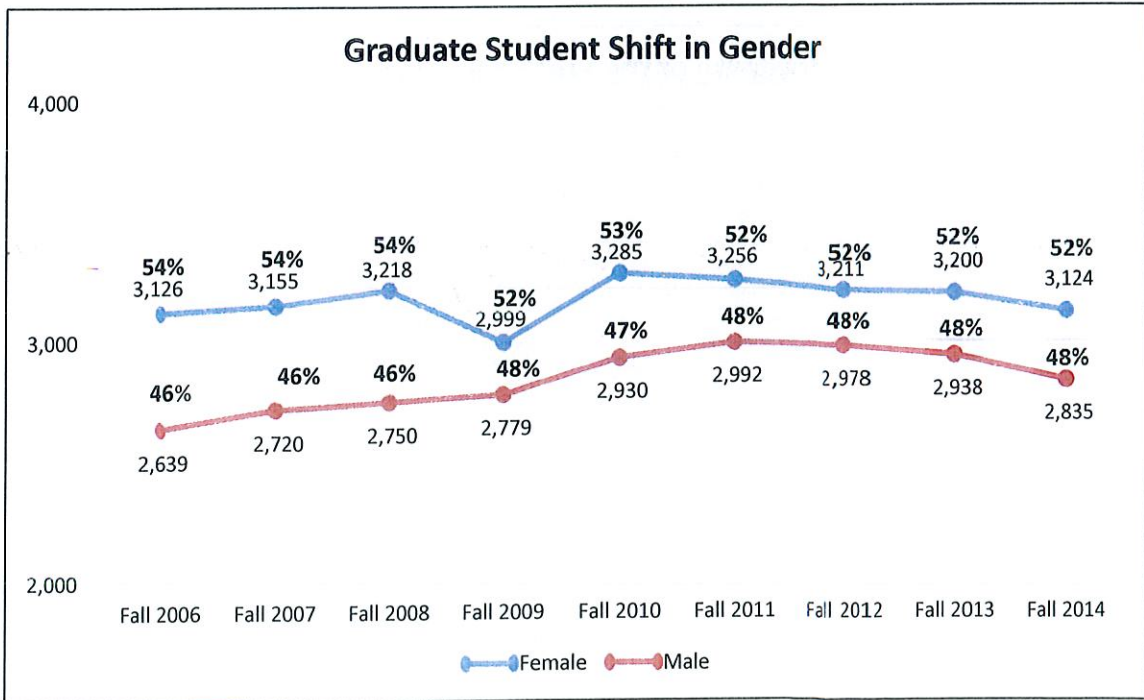
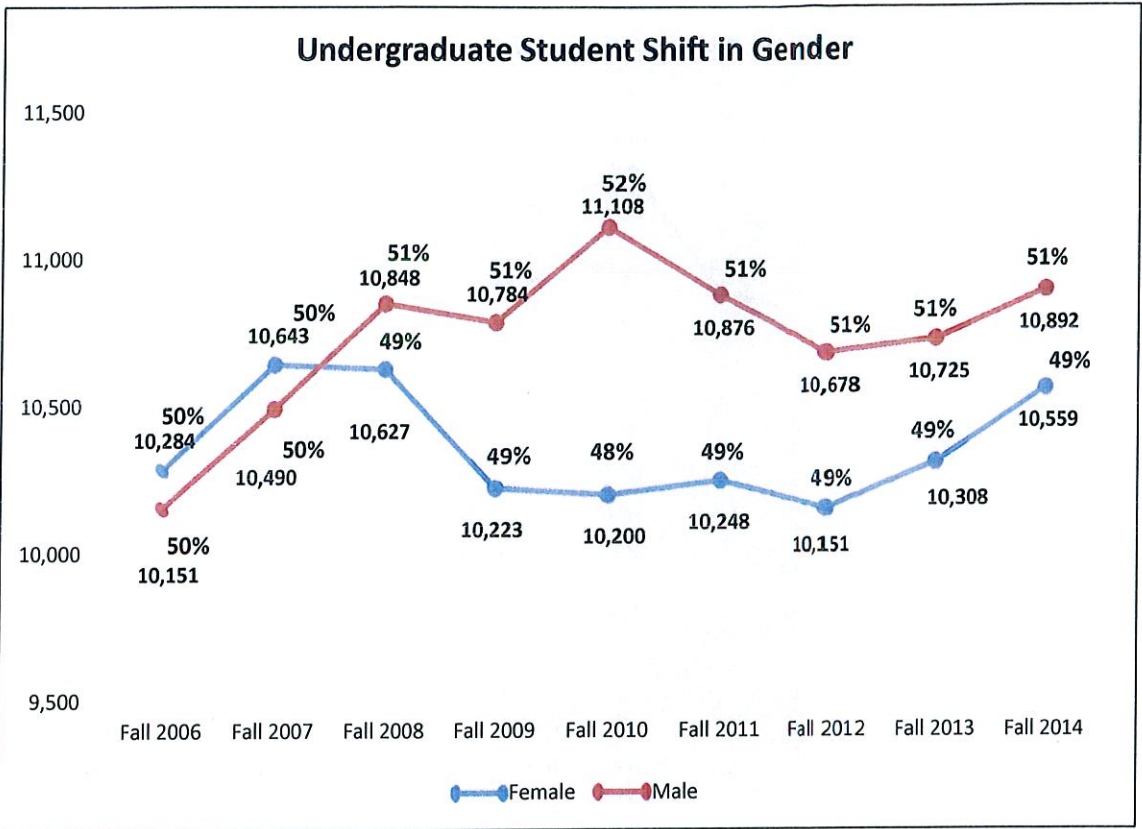

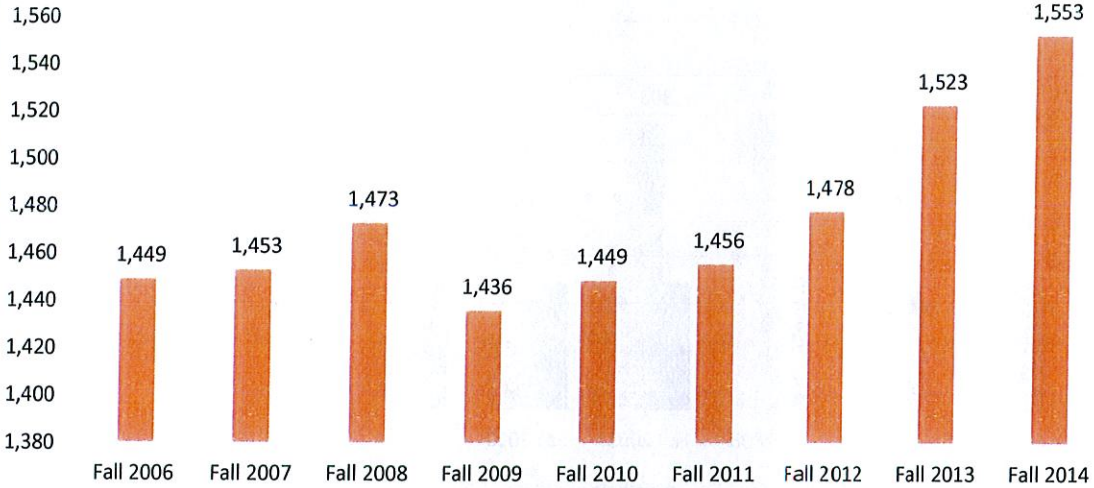




## Total Faculty

Includes Tenured and Tenure-Accruing Faculty

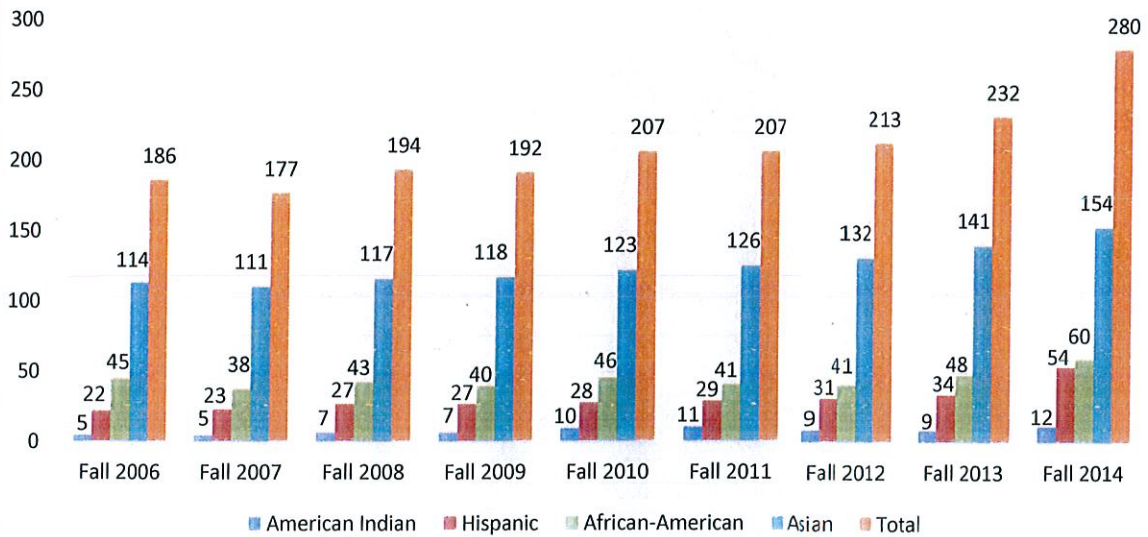
*UT-Knoxville has increased its total faculty by 7% since Fall 2006*

*American Indian and Hispanic have increased over 140% since 2006*

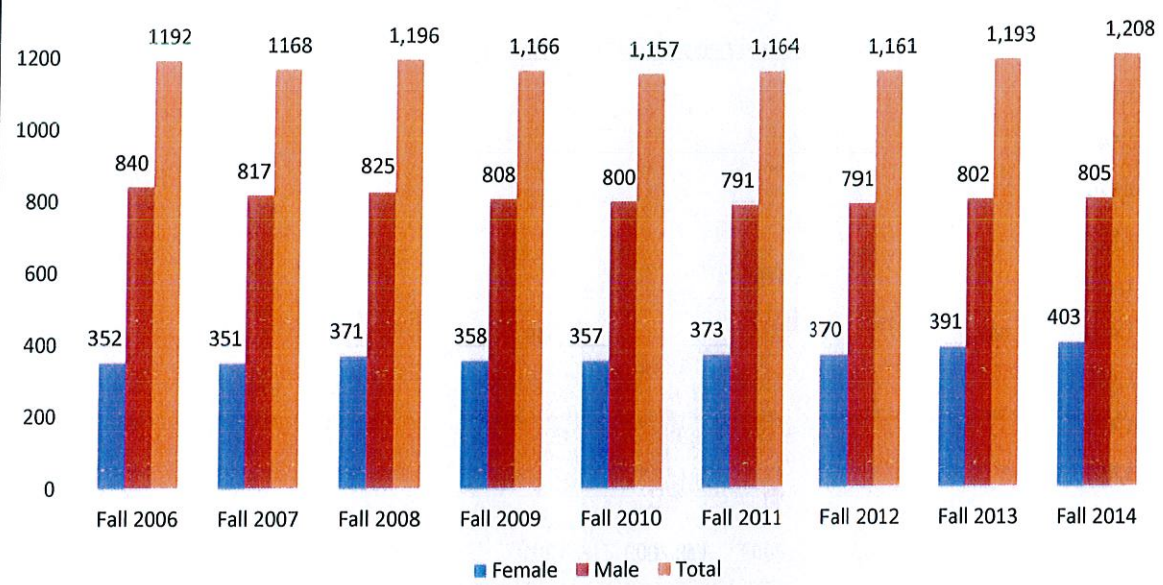
*African American and Asian have increased 33% and 35% respectively*
