## **SUMMARY OF CAMPUS CONCEALED CARRY RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

Effective July 1, 2016, Tennessee Code Annotated 39-17-1309 has been amended to allow full-time employees of public institutions of higher education to carry concealed handguns if they have a valid Tennessee handgun permit; are not enrolled as a student; and have provided written notification to the proper law enforcement agency.

However, the right to carry concealed handguns is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Employees shall not carry a handgun openly or in any other manner in which the handgun is visible to ordinary observation by a reasonable person.
- 2. Employees shall have their handgun carry permit in their immediate possession at all times when carrying a handgun.
- 3. Employees shall display their handgun carry permit on demand of a law enforcement officer.
- 4. Employees shall not carry a weapon other than a handgun.
- 5. Employees shall not carry a handgun at the following times or at the following locations:
  - Stadiums, gymnasiums, or auditoriums where University-sponsored events are in progress;
  - In meetings regarding student or employee disciplinary matters;
  - In meetings regarding tenure issues;
  - A hospital, a student health or counseling center, or an office where medical or mental health services are the primary services provided; or
  - Any location where a provision of state or federal law, except the posting provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-17-1359, prohibits the carrying of a handgun on that property, such as on the premises of a child care agency.

The University of Tennessee Police Department may provide scheduled training for full-time employees relating to handgun safety. Such training is voluntary.
