

## **Undergraduate Council E-Vote Summary Report – March 9, 2020**

The Undergraduate Council held an electronic vote on March 5-9, 2020, to approve the minutes of a Curriculum Committee e-vote conducted on February 26-28, 2020. These e-votes were needed in order to expedite the approval of curricular proposals from the College of Education, Health, and Human Sciences that were submitted on October 15, 2020, but inadvertently left off the Curriculum Committee meeting agenda for January 14, 2020.

**Curriculum (February 28):** The committee presented curricular proposals from the College of Education, Health, and Human Sciences for the 2020-2021 undergraduate catalog. Most of the proposals were low-impact course revisions; the mid-impact items were three new courses, three courses to be dropped, and one course to be archived. Additional proposals from CEHHS were reviewed at the Curriculum Committee meeting on January 14, 2020, and were approved by the Senate on March 2, 2020; some of those program changes cannot take effect unless the proposals above are approved. The Undergraduate Council approved all proposals, with a quorum of voting members participating in the e-vote.
