






-  X Yellow bars represent periods of time when departments and colleges prepare and approve curricular proposals. The "X" represents the deadline for submitting proposals to the UG and Graduate Curriculum Committees for consideration.
-  Blue bars represent periods of time when curricular proposals are shared with the entire University community for review and comment.
-  Orange squares represent UG and Graduate Curriculum Committee meetings.
-  Black squares represent UG and Graduate Council meetings.
-  Green squares represent Faculty Senate approval of UG and Graduate Council actions.

Proposals approved during Windows 1-4 will be able to take effect in the Fall semester of the following academic year.

Proposals approved during Window 5 will take effect in the Fall semester two academic years later, with the exception of the current UG Council pilot program that allows new courses approved in Spring to be added to the Fall UG Catalog if those courses do not satisfy major requirements or Volunteer Core requirements.
