



## **Statement Regarding the Leadership Change at the University**

Yesterday, the President of the University of Tennessee system, Joe DiPietro, announced the termination of Dr. Beverly Davenport as the Chancellor of the University of Tennessee, Knoxville.

This comes as a shock to all of us. Since her appointment in February of last year as our first female Chancellor, Dr. Davenport brought unity, knowledge, and strength to our campus, embodying the best qualities of this university. She has been an advocate and champion for women, campus workers, faculty, and marginalized students.

Even though she is no longer Chancellor, the impact Dr. Davenport has had on our campus is irrevocable.
